Ms. Seltz said during the third quarter 410 participants were provided Child Birth Education, 388 were provided Breastfeeding and 303 participants were provided Smoking Cessation training. Ms. Seltz said consent to participation is at 93% and ages and stages screens at 75%.</p> <p>Children’s Advocacy Center (Early Steps) – Karen Horzepa said the Early Steps program currently serving 647 children and provided an update to the members present.</p> <p>Children’s Medical Services – Judy Ryan said they are pushing to start medical home. Ms. Ryan said a meeting has been scheduled for Healthy Start to meet with the nurses.</p> <p>Halifax OB/GYN Associates – Pat Kruse said Dr Carbiener will be speaking with Bert-Fish in New Smyrna to expand their OB/GYN services. Ms. Kruse said they continue to provide services to Flagler County Health Department. Dr. Kruse said Dr. Modad will be opening an office in Flagler and they will be partnering with her. Ms. Kruse said they are working with one of the hospitals to get 2 birthing suites in the event a patient wants to experience a home environment birth.</p> <p>Volusia County Health Department – No report.</p> <p>Flagler County Health Dept - Bonnie Welter said recently experience a two month infant death.
