## **What are Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorders (FASD)?**

FASD is an umbrella term describing the range of effects that can occur in an individual whose mother drank alcohol during pregnancy. These effects may include physical, behavioral, mental and/or learning disabilities with possible lifelong implications.

**The Florida Center is home to the state's first and only Fetal Alcohol Diagnostic and Intervention Clinic which provides statewide training at No Cost on FASD including raising awareness; long term effects of prenatal exposure to alcohol and interventions for those affected with FASD.**
