Opioid Management for Women Past First Trimester

- Limited physicians accepting opioid managed pregnant women.
- Contact Healthy Start Women's Intervention Specialist at SMA at 386-254-1226
- Funding for West Volusia Hospital Authority will provide an additional WIS/NOS for Wrap around services with Family Source Wed. evenings and Saturdays.
- Other?



Continuing Gaps in Service

- Safety net of Health Department created a void for prenatal services with wrap-around care.
- Residential options for opioid managed women in Volusia/Flagler counties are not available.
- Cases continue to be complex and care coordination is critical.
- Payment for opioid management during pregnancy is not available through Medicaid in our service area.
- This results in some OB/GYN's not wanting to manage these patients



Post Partum/Neonatal/Infant

- Neonatal Outreach Services – expanding to West Volusia if WVHA funding approved
- Staffing in Hospital(s) – three times weekly – MOA with Healthy Start under review
- DCF and CPC coordination – family engagement, safe baby court team, Infant Mental Health, other?
- Family Planning – coordinate with Health Department



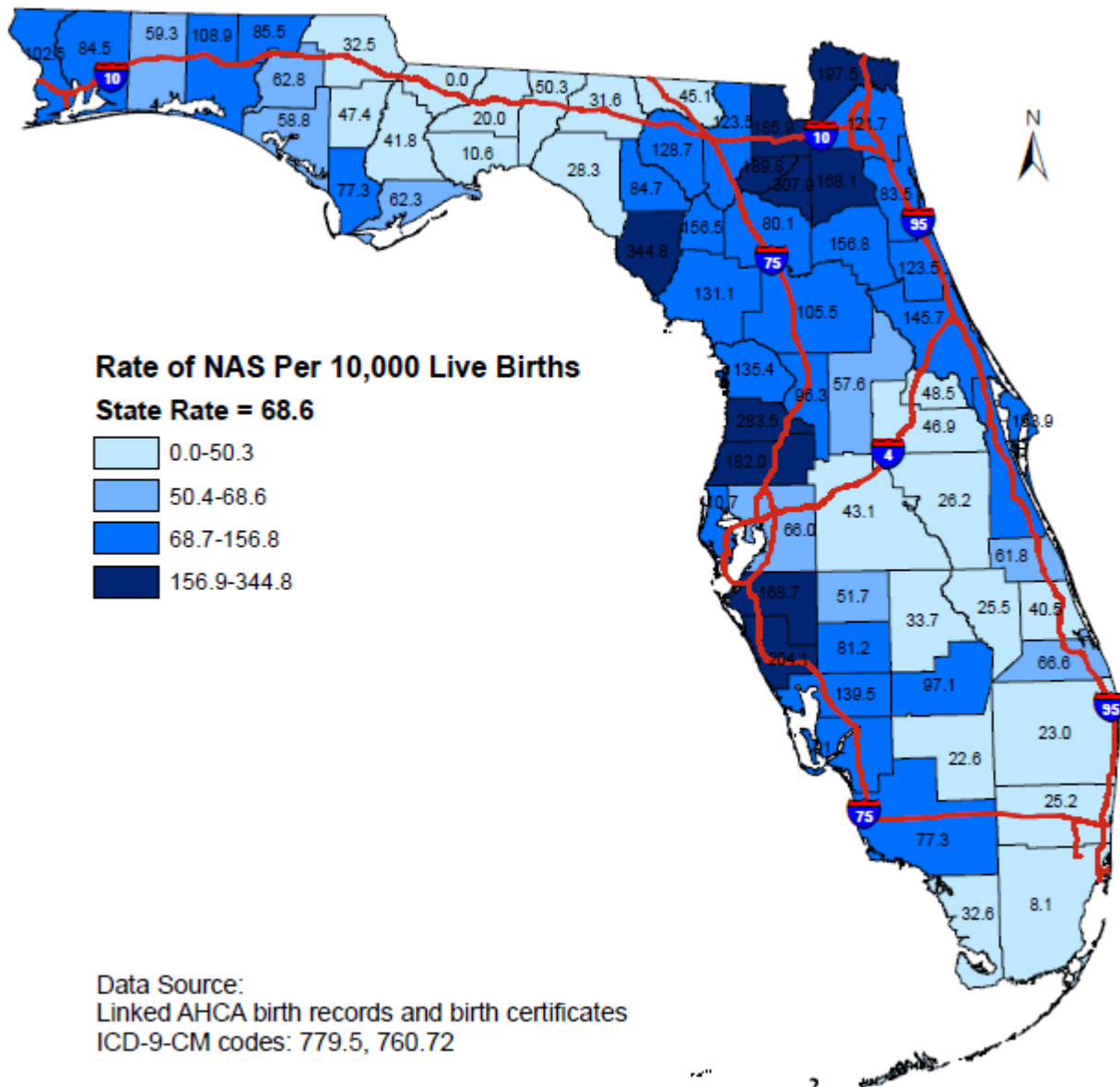
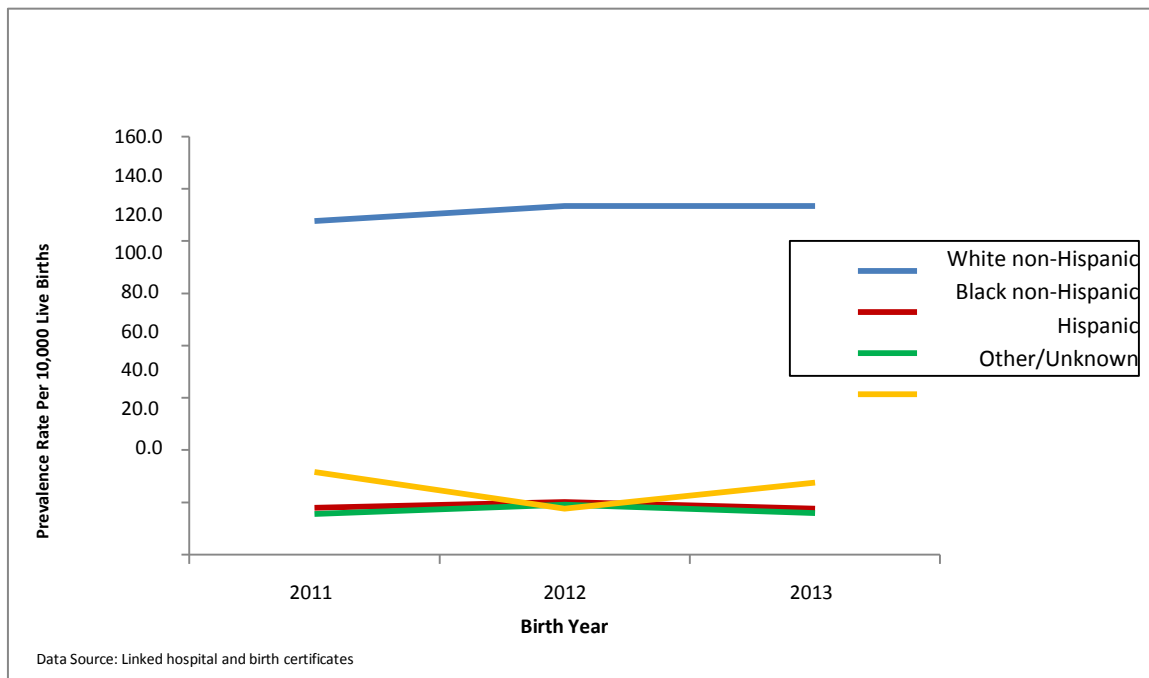


Figure 2. Prevalence Rates of Neonatal Abstinence Syndrome Per 10,000 Live Births by Maternal Race and Ethnicity, 2011-2013

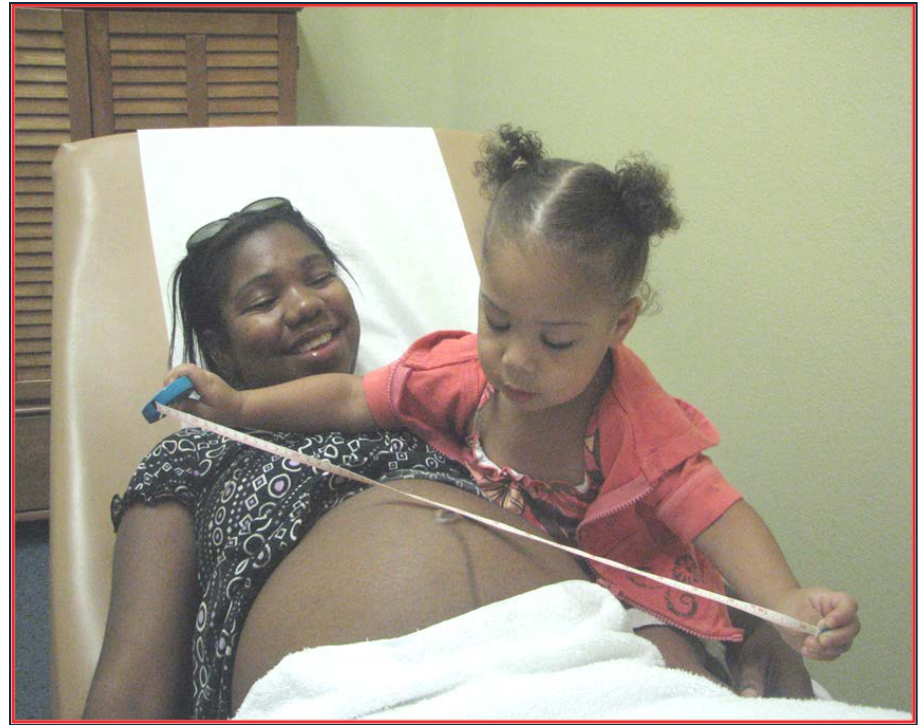


Events
